Terms and Conditions

1. **BOOKING:** The booking is provisional and will only be confirmed upon satisfactory weather forecast, usually 5 days before the trip.
2. **BALANCE:** The balance of the monies must be paid prior to departure of the trip.
3. **CANCELLATION:** If you cancel your booking within 5 days of your pre-arranged trip date, when the trip is still viable, you will be liable to pay the full balance, unless the trip can be re-sold
4. **INSURANCE:** whilst safety standards will be adhered to, the coastal trip is taken at your own liability. The company is in no way liable in respect of any personal injury, loss or illness suffered by a client. You are recommended to take out your own insurance if appropriate.
5. **ACCESS:** The nature of a coastal trip may render it unsuitable for anybody with physical disability. However, it may be possible to accommodate some passengers requiring disabled access, dependent on requirements and tide. Please enquire.
6. **CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS:** Under no circumstances will the proprietor be liable for any consequential loss or damage arising from the booking. Any liability on the part of the proprietor will be limited to the actual amount paid by the client.
7. **ARRIVING passengers:** A specific time will be arranged to meet for departure on the trip. This is normally from the pontoon area of Peel Marina. Depending on tidal information, it may be necessary to arrange departure from another point, such as the breakwater at Peel.
8. **PRICES:** are per trip and include light refreshments appropriate to the time of day. More substantial refreshments may be arranged by prior request. Alcoholic drinks may be provided by prior request, but should be consumed in moderation to ensure safety is maintained as a priority at sea.
9. **CHILDREN:** If children are taken on board, the accompanying passenger shall be fully responsible for their conduct and entertainment and no member of the crew shall be held responsible for their conduct or entertainment.
10. **PASSENGER NUMBERS:** whilst no more than 10 passengers may be accommodated for cruising on board, it may be possible to accommodate a limited additional number which the vessel is securely moored in port. This will be at the sole discretion of the Captain.
11. **CAPTAIN:** A suitably qualified Captain and suitably experienced Crew will accompany the trip. Passengers will be required to comply with all reasonable orders given to them by the Captain whilst aboard the vessel.
12. **COMPLAINTS:** Passengers shall give notice of any complaint in the first instance to the Captain on board and note shall be taken of the time, date and nature of the complaint.
13. **BAD WEATHER CONDITIONS:** following receipt of your booking preferences, you will be advised of favourable weather conditions for the coastal trip. In the event of bad weather immediately prior to departure, it may be necessary to cancel the trip. In the event of unexpected bad weather arising during the trip, it may be necessary to curtail the trip and return to port.
